Common Questions

1. Who can attend 4-H Camp?

Campers are boys and girls between 8-13 years of age as of September 1, 2008.

Counselors are teens between 14-18 years of age who have completed the Bay County Camp Counselor Training program and are selected to serve.

2. Do you have to be a Bay County 4-H member to attend Camp?

NO. However, Bay County 4-H members are given preference. By participating in 4-H Camp youth become 4-H members. Non 4-H members and youth from other counties may participate if space is available.

3. How many youth attend Camp?

Camp is limited to 110 youth; with 36 youth from each County.

4. How many adults will be at Camp?

4-H Agents and Volunteer 4-H Leaders attend as chaperones. Teens serve as cabin counselors. In addition, the camp is also staffed by 8-10 other adults.

5. How do I register for Camp?

Complete and return the attached form to request a **registration packet**. To reserve a space for camp you must submit a \$75 registration deposit.

6. Is there registration deadline?

Registrations are taken until the camp is full on a first come basis. Space is limited, so you should register early.

7. How will I know what to bring?

The **registration packet** will contain a list of all of the items that you will need for camp.

8. How much does 4-H Camp cost?

Total cost for Campers is \$200.
\$75 non-refundable* registration deposit is required to reserve a space for each child.
\$125 balance is due June 1, 2009

*Refund made only for medical reasons or mandatory summer school

9. What does the camp fee include?

- Transportation to and from camp via bus from the Panama City Mall
- All meals and Lodging
- Daily Canteen and Camp Tee-shirt

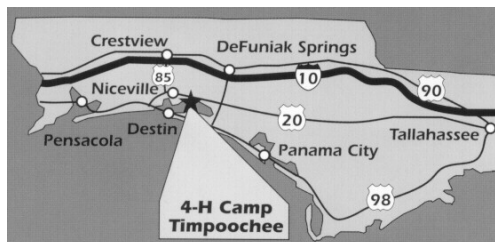
Youth who qualify for free or reduced school food program will receive a \$26.36 discount.

10. How do I get to Camp?

Campers will meet at the bus at the Panama City Mall at 8:30 am Monday, to board the bus for camp. The bus will return at ~12:30 p.m. on Friday. Arrangements may be made with the 4-H Agent for parents to transport their child to Camp.

11. Where is Camp Timpooshee?

4-H Camp Timpooshee is located in Okaloosa County on the Choctawhatchee Bay, off Hwy 20, just east of Niceville.



12. Are there scholarships for military children?
