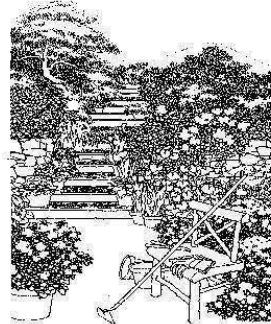

Bring with you:

1. Passport picture (available at drug stores, eg. CVS, Walgreen's) or 1½" x 1½" recent clear, full-face photo.
2. Current Picture ID (i.e. driver's license)

Upon passing the exam be prepared to provide a certificate of Insurance with a minimum of \$400,000 (FDACS Form 13654 or an Accord Form used by Insurance Agents).

Check must be written to UF/IFAS-Bay County Extension.

If you need only CEUs for renewal, attend from 8:00 am – 12:00 pm for \$25 and receive 4 CEUs in L&O, O&T, and CORE.

You can earn your limited commercial landscape maintenance pesticide license. Our County Extension office can help.

Is it the license you need?

If part of your business is applying herbicides (including Roundup) or certain pesticides to plant beds, the State of Florida requires that you have a limited pesticide license. Operating without one could mean a \$5,000 fine. Even more, it could increase your liability in case of an accident.

To get licensed, you need to take a 6-hour course and a written exam. But, if you're like many people, taking the time and money to go through the course, especially if you are uncomfortable with taking the exam, is really difficult. So, you put it off, again and again.

County Extension can help.

Because we have access to all the University's resources, we can give you the very best instructors and programs. Extension will make the 6-hour limited pesticide course easy, interesting and useful.
